

INDIGENOUS STUDIES (ISMC)

Certificate of Completion | Barrydowne & Online

A micro-credential is a Cambrian College Board of Governor's level certification awarded at Convocation. The Indigenous Studies Certificate of Completion is currently being offered to students who are taking a two-year diploma program or a three-year advanced diploma program, or to those wishing to take it as a stand-alone certificate.

In order to be eligible for this certificate, students must complete four courses within the Indigenous Studies area.

Certificate Requirements

In order to obtain the Certificate of Completion, four of the following courses must be completed:

Current Postsecondary Students

Students currently enrolled in a postsecondary program at Cambrian College may take this micro-credential concurrently with their diploma or advanced diploma program.

Whenever there is a General Education course within their program, students seeking the micro-credential should elect to take one of the four Health and Wellness courses. Since each program requires three General Education courses, students must enroll in one additional course (with applicable tuition and other fees), whether as an overload or through an off-stream term. Students will apply to graduate from the micro-credential upon completion.
